Project and Programme Review Committee Tenth Meeting Bonn, Germany, 11-12 December 2012

ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1. Opening of the meeting

The meeting will be opened by the Chair of the Project and Programme Review Committee (PPRC), Mr. Jeffery Spooner (Jamaica, Latin American and Caribbean Countries).

3. Options for the engagement of the scientific community in providing inputs on technical issues

Background: In its 9th meeting, the PPRC discussed engaging the scientific community especially as the Adaptation Fund did not have a dedicated scientific assessment panel. In its 18th meeting, having considered the comments and recommendations of the Projects and Programme Review Committee, the Adaptation Fund Board decided to:

- a) Issue a call for inputs from the public for comments on project/programme proposals for consideration in the technical reviews to be submitted no later than six weeks before each Board meeting using the comment function on the Adaptation Fund webpage;
- b) Make all substantive comments publicly available on the Adaptation Fund website and annexed to each relevant project/programme document; and
- c) Prepare a paper for consideration at the PPRC's 10th meeting on a strategy to engage the scientific community in providing inputs on proposals.

(Decision B.18/24)

The paper contained in the document AFB/PPRC.10/3 has been prepared by the secretariat for this purpose.

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to hear a presentation by the secretariat on the document AFB/PPRC.10/3, to discuss it, and to make recommendations to the Board if necessary.

4. Report of the secretariat on initial screening/technical review of the submitted project and programme proposals
