

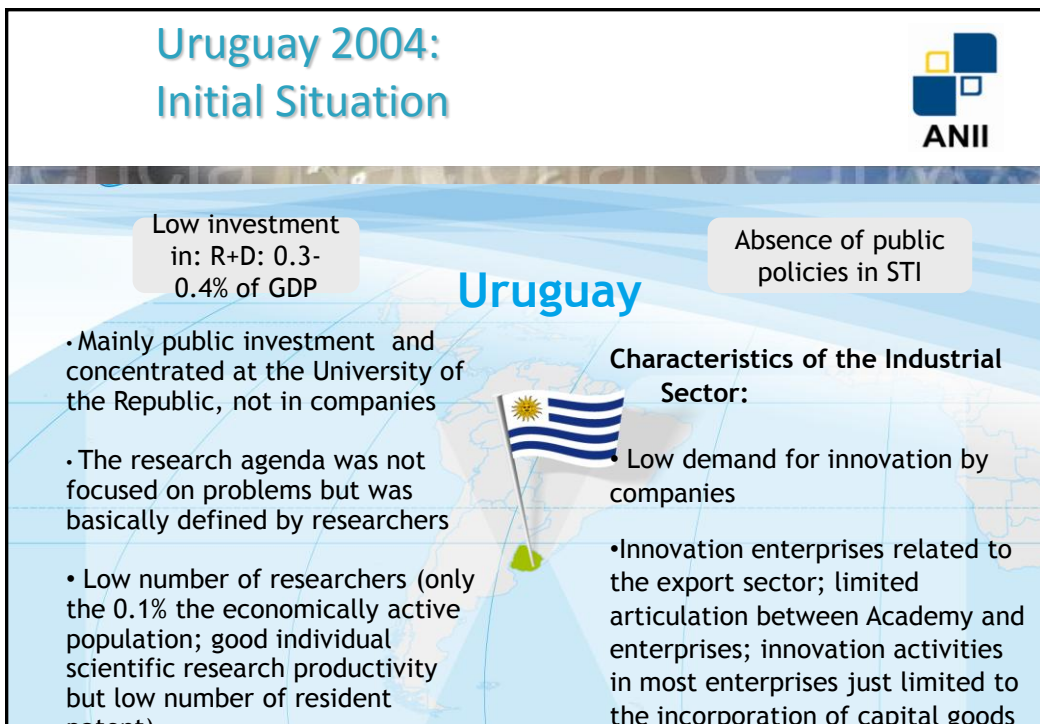
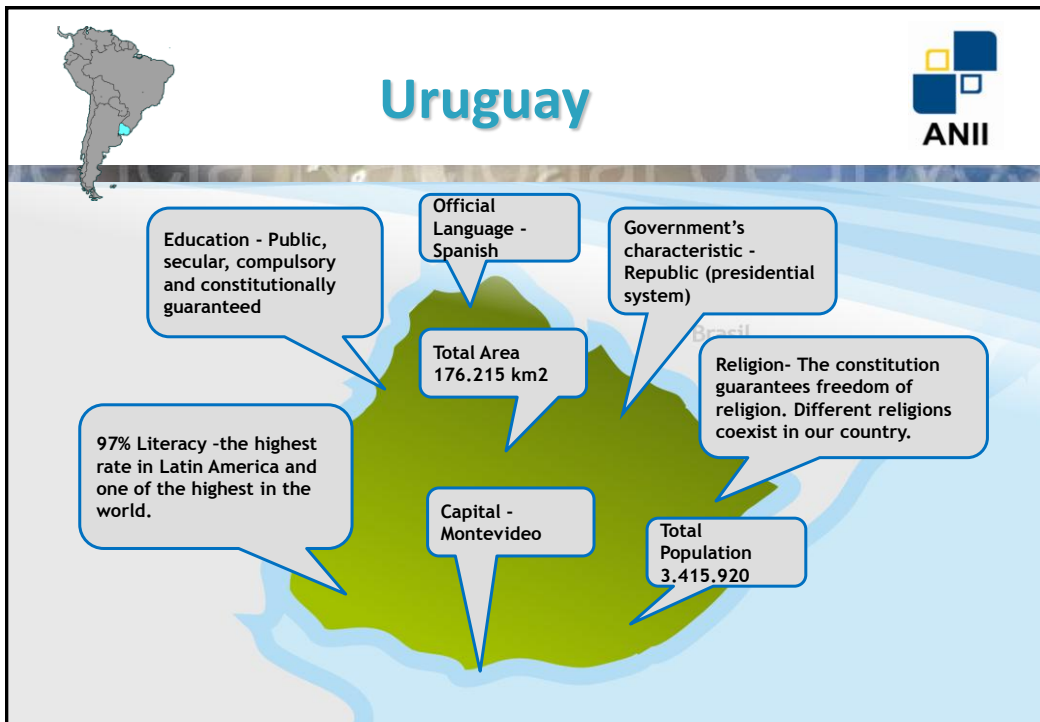

ANII A new institution that does not define R+D+i policies, it responds, orchestrates and implements the definitions decided at the scope of the **Cabinet of Innovation**.

ANII 's objectives



- ANII's main objectives include the design, organization and administration of plans, programs and instruments oriented towards the scientific-technological development, as well as the reinforcement and deployment of innovation capabilities.
- Encourage the coordination and articulation between several actors involved in the creation and application of knowledge in order to power up the synergy between them and exploit as much as possible the available resources.

Three sets of instruments



- To foster R+D capabilities and human resources training
- Subsidies to share innovation risk in enterprises and to increase competitiveness
- Support for the coordination between academy and production actors towards innovation activities.

PsycBOOKS

Base de datos con 1566 libros en texto completo, especializados en Psicología y áreas relacionadas. Con la base de datos PsycBOOKS accederá a más de 25.000 capítulos de libros publicados por la APA y demás editoras del área.

La base de datos PsycBOOKS también pone a su disposición más de 1.500 registros de la "Encyclopedia of Psychology" da APA/Oxford University Press.
