

15. Lands and Soil Conservation



- Avoid impacting productive lands
- Practice soil conservation (fragile, soil loss)

Risk and Impact Signaling

Category A – likely to have significant adverse E&S impacts that are diverse, widespread, or irreversible

Category B – potential adverse impacts that are fewer in number, smaller in scale, less widespread, reversible or easily mitigated

Category C – no adverse E&S impacts


E&S Management Plan

- Plan that captures the actions identified to manage risks and impacts
- Integrate ESMP into operations and not stand-alone
- Update ESMP with results of on-going monitoring
- Commitment to implement is a condition of AF approval
- Include results in reporting to AF

Monitoring & Reporting

- Commensurate with risks and impacts
- Related to ESMS
- Informed by consultations
- Results of monitoring should inform future
- Report annually to AF
