Adaptation Fund Board Project and Programme Review Committee Eighteenth Meeting Bonn, Germany, 15-16 March 2016

ANNOTATED PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1. Opening of the meeting

In the absence of Ms. Yuka Greiler (Switzerland, Western European and Others Group), outgoing Chair of the PPRC, the meeting will be opened by the outgoing Vice-Chair of the Project and Programme Review Committee (PPRC), Mr. Yerima Peter Tarfa (Nigeria, African States).

2. Transition of the Chair and the Vice-Chair

Background: The Adaptation Fund Board (the Board) decided, in its twenty-sixth meeting, to elect Mr. Yerima Peter Tarfa (Nigeria, African States) and Mr. Hugo Potti Manjavacas (Spain, Annex I Parties) as Chair and Vice-Chair of the PPRC, respectively, for a term beginning at the 27th meeting and ending at the first meeting of 2017. However Mr. Manjavacas has recently resigned from the Board and his replacement has not been finalized yet.

Action expected: The outgoing Vice-Chair will take over the chairmanship of the PPRC as the incoming Chair.

3. Organizational matters

a) Adoption of the agenda

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to adopt the agenda for the meeting and to raise any other matters it may wish to discuss, to be included on the agenda under item 9.

Background: The Chair will propose to the PPRC the organization of work.

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to approve the organization of work as proposed by the Chair.

4. Update on the funding status

Document: None.

Background: Following new contributions made in the eleventh session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol, the funding status of the Fund has progressed.

Action expected: the secretariat will give an update of the availability of funds to fund project and programme proposals, including proposals to be submitted by Multilateral Implementing Entities (MIEs).

5. Funding for proposals under the pilot programme for regional activities.

Document: None.

Background: In its twenty-sixth meeting, the Board had discussed the issue of the pilot programme for regional projects and it was pointed out that it would be useful for the Board to request the PPRC at its next meeting to make a recommendation to the Board on how to address the fact that the number of projects being approved could exceed the cap of US\$ 30 million set for this pilot. A survey of stakeholders by the secretariat had indicated that there was tremendous demand for regional projects, a demand which was in excess of US\$ 200 million. For the twenty-sixth meeting only, the seven pre-concept proposals considered by the PPRC amounted to a total of US\$ 59.9 million. The four pre-concepts endorsed at the twenty-sixth meeting had combined funding requests of US\$ 28.9 million. Any additional projects approved would already exceed the cap set for the pilot programme.

The Chair of the Board said that as the item had not been placed on the agenda of the Board he did not think that it was desirable to make a recommendation at the present time. However, the issue could be placed on the agenda of the PPRC for its next meeting, and it should be discussed before any other proposals for funding under the pilot programme were considered. Action expected: the secretariat will give an overview of the number and requested amount of regional pre-concepts and concepts submitted to the Board since its twenty-sixth meeting, to help in a PPRC discussion and recommendation to the Board, if any.

6. Report of the secretariat on initial screening/technical review of project and programme proposals.

Background: In its twenty-fifth meeting, the Board decided to:

- (a) Approve the pilot programme on regional projects and programmes, as contained in document AFB/B.25/6/Rev.2;
- (b) Set a cap of US\$ 30 million for the programme;
- (c) Request the secretariat to issue a call for regional project and programme proposals for consideration by the Board in its twenty-sixth meeting; [...]

(Decision B.25/28)

Pursuant to decision B.25/28 (c), the secretariat issued, on 5 May 2015, an invitation to submit project and programme proposals for funding under the pilot programme. The secretariat had received a number of eligible proposals during its twenty-sixth meeting. The Board also decided during that meeting to request the secretariat to inform the Multilateral Implementing Entities and Regional Implementing Entities that the call for proposals under the Pilot Programme for Regional Projects and Programmes was still open and to encourage them to submit proposals to the Board at its 27th meeting, bearing in mind the cap established by Decision B.25/26 (Decision B.26/3). The secretariat has received a number of newly submitted proposals along with proposals that were resubmitted following non endorsement (in the case of resubmission of pre-concepts) or endorsement (in the case of submission of concepts) at the twenty-sixth meeting.

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to consider the project/programme proposals submitted with their corresponding technical review sheets, and the final consolidated comments of the secretariat. Further, the PPRC will be invited to make recommendations on each proposal to the Board for adoption. The PPRC will also be invited to consider the Project Formulation Grant requests contained in respective documents and to make recommendations on them to the Board for adoption.

9. Experience gained by the PPRC in operationalizing decision B.25/15 (tracking of changes made to the previous versions of proposals)

Background: At its twenty-fifth meeting, the Board had decided to experiment a system of tracking the changes made to proposals from previous meetings and had requested the PPRC to consider, at its eighteenth meeting, the experience gained by the PPRC in operationalizing this decision (Decision B.25/15).

Action expected: The secretariat will remind the PPRC of the changes introduced following decision B.25/15 and inform the PPRC on how the decision has been applied so far by project/programme proponents when submitting proposals to the twenty-sixth and twenty-seventh meetings of the Board. The PPRC will be invited to exchange on its own experience in reviewing the proposals using the system of tracking the changes through highlighted text.

10. Other matters.

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to discuss any other matters raised during the adoption of the agenda.

11. Adoption of the report

Document: The report of the PPRC will be prepared after the session on 16 March 2016.

Action expected: The PPRC Chair will report to the Board on the deliberations of the PPRC and on agreed recommendations to the Board.
