

## **Brief Description of the CTCN**

- Operative arm of the UNFCCC Technology Mechanism
- "Enhance transfer and development of climate technology solutions to developing countries, upon request"
- 151 CTCN National Designated Entities (as of today)
- 3 core services and 14 sectors
- Hosted by UNEP with Consortium of 14 organisations
- 180+ Network members from private, academic, NGO sectors

- 127 Requests from 60+ countries
- 67 being signed or implemented
- USD25k to USD250k
- 3-12 months
- By request by NDE
- Implemented by CTCN Network







# How and when to request CTCN technical assistance

#### How to request CTCN assistance:

- 1. 'Proponent' gains endorsement of NDE
- 2. Submit request (3 pages)
- Eligibility criteria: relevance to (i) CC priorities;
  (ii) national plans; (iii) sustainability
- 4. Prioritisation criteria: balancing of (i) geography balancing; (ii) adaptation/mitigation; (iii) stage of technology cycle
- 5. CTCN design technical assistance workplan (with NDE/proponent)
- 6. CTCN selects best available implementer from 180+ Network members
- 7. Implementation overseen by CTCN and NDE
- 8. Evaluation by NDE/proponent and CTCN

When to request:

- For AF project developing: During design of concept notes of full proposals
- Request accepted by CTCN at any time during the year
