Enabling Adaptation



Adaptation should be a country-driven, evidencebased, gender-sensitive and flexible process



All key stakeholders dealing with natural resources must work together



To meet all adaptation needs, climate finance should be 6 to 13 times greater by 2030 from both domestic and international sources


Priorities of MENA Region

- 88% include <u>adaptation</u> in their INDCs.
- 95% percent refer to water, crops and livestock.
- 85% highlight climate change <u>impact on water</u> <u>services.</u>
- Many countries mention the need to carry <u>vulnerability and impact</u> <u>assessment</u>, and
- Link with actions against <u>desertification</u>

- Adapting agriculture to climate change is closely linked to water management
- Innovative and sustainable watermanagement technologies, combined with appropriate policies and strategies, will help in the adaptation to climate change





Support to Morocco's 4C:

Centre de Compétences en Changement Climatique

Two main components:

- **Capacity building** on the development of the National Adaptation Plan, the GHG inventory, the NDC and on access to climate finance
- Promote North-South and South-South collaborations through exchanges with experts and between countries

Way forward

- Assist countries to develop proposals to access climate finance, or provide technical support during project implementation
- New funding opportunity to support countries on NAP through the GCF readiness: 3M USD/country
- Support Member States with developing GCF country work programs for the agriculture sectors
- For **SDG** 6 on Water: investment in agriculture, the main use of water, will be central for countries in MENA region.

 The Global Water Scarcity Initiative will be launched at COP 22 in Marrakech, supporting Morocco's Initiative on Adaptation for Agriculture in Africa (TRIPLE A)
