US\$ 110.4 MILLION

Adaptation Fund (AF) has allocated US\$ 110.4 million to 15 concrete adaptation projects in 14 SIDS countries. Altogether 17 SIDS countries have received support from the AF (Readiness & Project Formulation Grants included).

8300 ha of natural habitat restored / protected

7700 people trained in climate resilience measures

99 km of coastline protected

SIDS PROJECTS

Examples of some of the AF projects in the SIDS.

FIJ

- US\$ 4.24 million urban development project implemented by UN-Habitat
- Increasing the resilience of informal urban settlements highly vulnerable to climate change and disaster risks
- 6000 direct beneficiaries, 220 trained in cyclone resilient construction methods, business skills and microfinance access and coastal zone management


ANTIGUA & BARBUDA

- US\$ 9.97 million multisector project implemented by Department of Environment (Direct Access)
- Integrating physical adaptation and community resilience
- 3 km of McKinnon's waterway restored and upgraded

GUINEA-BISSAU

- US\$ 9.97 million agriculture project implemented by BOAD
- Scaling up climate-smart agriculture in East Guinea-Bissau
- 54,516 direct beneficiaries, 700 producers and farmers trained
