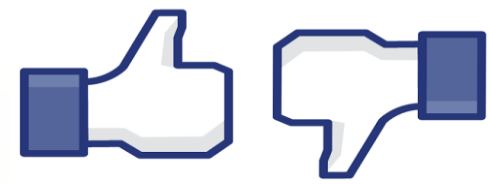

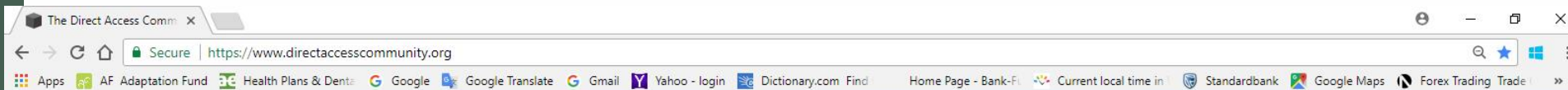

# On CPDAE Consider Discussing



- ▶ What are the common challenges in addressing ESS and gender issues in project development under the AF.
- ▶ Adequate identification, assessment and addressing of environmental, social and gender issues in projects/programmes requires consulting multiple stakeholders that could be impacted or that may have a vested interest in the project/programme. How do you address multi-stakeholder consultation and engagement to enable the collection of relevant information to address environmental and social risks and gender issues, particularly looking at marginalized groups, stakeholder engagement, involuntary resettlement, and gender equality etc?
- ▶ As an NIE or senior management, how do you get feedback on your plans for project preparation and how do you record/capture the relevant information for the project?
