Proposal for Mongolia (UN-Habitat)

Mongolia: Flood Resilience in Ulaanbaatar Ger Areas - Climate Change Adaptation through community-driven small-scale protective and basic-services interventions (Full Proposal; United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat); MNG/MIE/DRR/2017/1; (US\$ 4,495,235)

Having considered the intersessional technical review of the fully-developed project document carried out by the secretariat and the Project and Programme Review Committee (PPRC), and the recommendation of the PPRC, the Adaptation Fund Board decides to:

- (a) To approve the fully-developed project proposal, as supplemented by the clarification responses provided by the; United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) to the request made by the technical review;
- (b) To approve the funding of US \$ 4,495,235 for the implementation of the project, as requested by UN-Habitat; and
- (c) To request the secretariat to draft an agreement with UN-Habitat as the multilateral implementing entity for the project.
