Receiving contributions from private sources

The Adaptation Fund Board decided to:

- a) Take note of the plan by Cool Effect, Inc. to mobilize and channel resources for the Adaptation Fund from various sources, including from private individuals and organizations, as described in documents AFB/B.31-32/13/Rev.1 and AFB/B.31-32/13/Add.1/Rev.1;*
- b) To request the secretariat to prepare a framework agreement between the Board and Cool Effect, Inc. to provide a framework to enable Cool Effect, Inc. to channel its mobilized contributions to the Adaptation Fund drawing on the example of the framework agreement between the Board and the United Nations Foundation made in October 2012;*
- c) To request the Chair of the Board, on behalf of the Board, to sign the framework agreement referred to in subparagraph (b) above;*
- d) To request the secretariat to arrange with Cool Effect, Inc. a public announcement of the new resource mobilization arrangement with Cool Effect, Inc.; and*
- e) To request the secretariat to review, while monitoring the implementation of the resource mobilization strategy 2017-2020 approved by the Board through decision B.28/44, any issues that would indicate the need for a more comprehensive policy framework related to non-governmental donors, and to report on such issues and to make necessary recommendations pursuant to them, to the Board in reports on implementation of the resource mobilization strategy.*
