Background: The Board at its twenty-fifth meeting had approved the pilot programme on regional projects and programmes (Decision B.25/28). At its twenty-eighth meeting it had considered the matter of the pilot programme for regional projects and programmes, especially a proposal from the PPRC for prioritization among regional project/programme proposals, including for awarding project formulation grants, and for establishment of a pipeline. The Board decided to permanently establish a funding window for regional projects and programmes within the Fund, but also (Decision B.28/1 a) (ii)): To request the secretariat to report on the progress and experiences of the pilot programme to the PPRC at its twenty-third meeting.

Document AFB/PPRC.23/3 is fulfilling the request from the Board to report on the progress and experiences of the pilot programme to the PPRC at its twenty-third meeting, as outlined in para (a) (ii) of the decision above. The report covers the funding window for regional projects and programmes, with a focus on projects and programmes submitted under the pilot programme.

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to discuss the findings and recommendations of the document and take appropriate action.

4. Programme for innovation

a) Small grants through Direct Access modality;

Document: AFB/PPRC.23/4 Programme on Innovation: Small grants projects through Direct Access modality

Background: The Board at its thirtieth meeting adopted the Medium Term Strategy, in Decision B.30/42, and at the thirty first the Implementation Plan for the Medium Term Strategy, in Decision B.31/32. The MTS implementation plan describes that at least 28 small grants will be awarded to a national implementing entities (NIEs) using the established NIE modality/s”, and launch a first Request for Proposals at COP 24 (Dec 2018)”.

Document AFB/PPRC.23/4 is fulfilling the request to prepare a specific document containing objectives, review criteria, expected grant sizes, implementation modalities, review process and other relevant features and submit it to the Board for its consideration in accordance with the tentative timeline contained in Annex I to document AFB/B.31/5/Rev.1, with input from the Board’s committees, towards announcing it/them at COP 24.

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to discuss the findings and recommendations of the document and take appropriate action.

b) Small grants projects through a multilateral implementing entity aggregator.

Background: The Board at its thirtieth meeting adopted the Medium Term Strategy, in Decision B.30/42, and at the thirty first the Implementation Plan for the Medium Term Strategy, in Decision B.31/32. The MIE aggregator is described in the MTS as a vehicle through which at least 40 small grants would be awarded to non-accredited entities. The MTS implementation plan also provides a timeline whereby the MIE “partner(s)” are to be “proposed to Board in October 2018 and announced at COP 24 (Dec 2018)”.

Document AFB/PPRC.23/5 is fulfilling the request to propose MIE partner(s) to Board in October 2018, towards announcing it/them at COP 24.

Action expected: The PPRC will be invited to discuss the findings and recommendations of the document and take appropriate action.
