B. Type of support requested

Please, find below the description of the activities to be undertaken with the support in compliance with the NIE Fund's Environmental, Social and Gender Policy:

The Fonds Interprofessionnel pour la Recherche et le Conseil Agricoles (FIRCA), under the provisions of Law No. 2001-635 dated 9th October, 2001 and the establishment of the Agricultural Development Fund ratified by Decree No. 2002-520 dated 11th December, 2002, and legally constituted on the 28th of October, 2003, is a legal entity of private law of a particular type recognized as being of public utility, sui generis status.

The objective of the FIRCA is aimed at ensuring the financing of agricultural services programs for farmers in the following areas:

- (i) Applied Agronomic and Forestry Research
- (ii) Agricultural council/extension
- (iii)Training in trades
- (iv)Capacity building for professional agricultural organizations.

FIRCA has two essential missions:

- (i) to mobilize financial resources from the agricultural sectors, the state and development partners and
- (ii) to ensure the sustainable financing of programs for the provision of services to the agricultural sectors.

In light of the new provisions by the Fund's Policy, the FIRCA has decided to update and develop its Environmental, Social and Gender Policy to make them more consistent with the current development (and as part of the accreditation process) of the Adaptation Fund.

This support, however, will be used to audit the implementation of these two policies (ESS and Gender) within the institution in order to assess the level of implementation and make recommendations for better integration into the institution's developmental policies.

All activities will be carried out by individual consultants.

At the end of this consultation, the following results are expected:

- The audit of the implementation of the ESS is carried out and an action plan is drawn up with a view to better integrating the ESS into the FIRCA's development policies.
- -An updated manual integrating the principles of the fund is available within the FIRCA.
- The FIRCA has a gender mainstreaming manual.
- The complaint management mechanism is updated taking into account the Fund's principles and a reporting template is made available.
