REQUEST FOR DIRECT PROJECT SERVICES: FUNDECOOPERACIÓN PARA EL DESARROLLO SOSTENIBLE (COSTA RICA)

Background

1. The Adaptation Fund Board (the Board) at its at its twenty-fourth meeting, approved a five-year project titled "Reducing the Vulnerability by Focusing on Critical Sectors (Agriculture, Water Resources and Coastlines) in order to Reduce the Negative Impacts of Climate Change and Improve the Resilience of these Sectors" submitted by e Fundecooperación para el Desarrollo Sostenible (Fundecooperación) for a requested amount of US\$ 9,970,000 (decision B.24/8).

2. The overall objective of the project is to reduce climate vulnerability by focusing on critical sectors (agriculture, water resources, and coastal zones) in order to reduce the negative impacts of climate change and improve the resilience of those populations. This programme will seek to increase climate resilience by working directly with local stakeholders and anticipated beneficiaries through the implementation of adaptation projects in each of the geographical areas selected.

3. As of February 2021, a total amount of US\$ 8,572,034 had been disbursed to the project by the Trustee, corresponding to 86% of the project funding. In addition, the project has submitted 4 project performance reports (PPR) expected during project implementation, which received all a self-rating of satisfactory. The 4th PPR was cleared by the Adaptation Fund Board Secretariat (the secretariat) on October 2020, and the fifth PPR is expected by the first quarter of 2021.

4. In January 2020, the Board has granted a first no-cost extension of the project completion date from 7 October 2020 to 7 April 2022 (Decision B.34-35/19).

5. On 2 December 2020, the secretariat received a request from Fundecooperación, informing that some of its executing entities (EE) had requested support in the provision of Direct Project Services (DSP) (Annex 4). The request for DPS provision when the project is under implementation, is described in the Operational Policies and Guidelines (OPG) Annex 7, that reports "In cases where a request for DPS is submitted to the secretariat for a project/programme that has been already been approved by the Board, which is only possible on an exceptional basis, the IEs shall submit all the relevant justification for the DPS explaining how the costs were established, along with a letter from the Designated Authority of the Adaptation Fund for the country(ies) of the project/programme endorsing the DPS".

6. The rational for the request of DPS provision at this stage of the project implementation, is due to the fact that the management of funds by the public sector is not as efficient, and some of the executing entities do not possess adequate expertise in resources management, which is delaying the execution of some of the project activities. Specifically, the EEs which had requested this support from Fundecooperación are public sector entities: i) Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock; ii) National Institute of Innovation and Agricultural Knowledge Transfer; and iii) The National Seeds Office, among others.

7. The execution services proposed to be devolved to Fundecooperación are: i) procurement of goods and services and payments on behalf of the EEs; and ii) Recruitment of project staff for the implementation of the sub-projects. For the procurement processes, the EEs will indicate and confirm specifications for all procurement goods and services that would be needed for the implementation of the sub-projects. For the recruitment of project staff, the EEs will remain in charge of preparing the TORs for all project staff and consultants.

8. The Implementing Entity confirms that there will be no need for budget reallocation associated with the requested DPS, which will be covered from the execution cost budget and

represent 1.4% of the total programme cost and 14.4% of the programme execution cost (see Annex 2).

9. Additionally, this request has been discussed and approved by the Project Steering Committee and the Project Management Board, and has been endorsed by the Designated Authority (DA) (Annex 3).

Secretariat's review of the request

10. Following a review of the request, and considering that this project is implemented through the enhanced direct access modality involving more than 40 different EEs, the secretariat finds that the request from Fundecooperación to provide DPS to four of its EEs, previously specified, is justified and will ensure timely delivery of project activities and utilization of funds, in line with the Adaptation Fund Policies.

11. Finally, the secretariat acknowledges that this request has been agreed by the Project Steering Committee and the Project Management Board and has been endorsed by the Designated Authority, in accordance with the Adaptation Fund OPG Annex 7.

Recommendation

12. The Board may consider and decide to approve, on an exceptional basis, the provision by Fundecooperación of a no-additional-cost Direct Project Services for the project "Reducing the Vulnerability by Focusing on Critical Sectors (Agriculture, Water Resources and Coastlines) in order to Reduce the Negative Impacts of Climate Change and Improve the Resilience of these Sectors".

We will highly appreciate your kind confirmation that we would be allowed to provide Direct Services under the above-mentioned considerations.
