PACT 2021 AF Initiatives



- Developed two grants under the Enhanced Direct Access (EDA) and Large Innovation Grant Funding Windows
- EDA Grant had a national scope and covered a larger number of stakeholders from various sectors
- Innovation Grant targeted Rural Development and Water Management in Southern and Northern Belize (4 Communities)



Main Challenges

Main Challenges faced when Accessing Grant



- Lack of climate data to substantiate the need for climate action in target communities
 - Limited resources in country to carry out assessments within each selected community (data only available at best, at the national level)
 - Timeframe required to conduct assessment to attain data is lengthy
- Covid-19
 - National restrictions in place that limit the engagement with stakeholders. Resulting in limited consultations with target communities especially in rural areas

Main Challenges faced when Accessing Grant



- Required expertise for the development of all concept notes may not be existent within the NIE
 - Some concepts require specific technical expertise for the accurate presentation of project activities and to complete the cost-benefit analysis
- Presentation of 'Innovation' aspect of project in line with AF requirements
 - As a relatively new funding window, additional training for NIEs may be required to improved access to the innovation funding window



Advice to NIEs

Advice to NIE's to aid access to the Grants



- Throughout the year engage national stakeholders/potential executing entities as the process to developing a CN is lengthy
 - Stress the importance of collecting data specific to the target communities over an extended period of time
 - This includes community demographics and gender disaggregated data
- Establish and maintain relationships with partner agencies that can support the development of concept notes/proposals via targeted expertise

Advice to NIE's to aid access to the Grants



- Utilize lines of communications established by potential executing entities
 - Many of the executing entities have a history of conducting interventions in the target communities; assist in garnering support
 - Needs of target communities may be preidentified under other initiatives and are beneficial to the development of new projects
 - Hence, use these as a basis for the development of project actions
- Build on other national initiatives (ongoing or completed)



Recommendations on AF Secretariat





- Increase Number of Peer Exchanges
- Conduct Training Sessions for NIEs on the accessing of the new funding windows as they become available
- Develop Technical Manuals for each Funding Window and Target Areas
