Background

The Adaptation Fund's mandate is to finance concrete adaptation projects in developing countries with a focus on the most vulnerable communities. The Fund, established in 2001, has been operational since 2007 and has been serving the Paris Agreement since 2019 and is a key channel for delivering dedicated support for adaptation.

Objective

The Adaptation Fund invites Parties and Observers to an open information session on the recent updates of the Fund during the SB58 Bonn Climate Change Conference in Bonn, Germany. This event will present recent updates and trends in adaptation finance and showcase new strategic directions for enhancing the ambition and impact of adaptation finance, including the Adaptation Fund's new Medium-term Strategy for the period 2023 - 2027. The Fund will also brief on recent and upcoming developments in the work of the Fund, followed by a Q&A session.
