Four key decisions were taken at the AFB.44 in relation to Accreditation

Analysis of the re-accreditation
process



Accreditation and re-accreditation
of 3 NIEs

Analysis of Re-accreditation Process of the Fund

Having considered the recommendation of the Accreditation Panel, the Board decided to request the secretariat:

- (a) To initiate work to conduct an in-depth analysis of the re-accreditation approach with a view to assess the long-term operational and budgetary implications, and
- (b) To present the outcome of the said analysis to the Accreditation Panel at its forty-fourth meeting.

Accreditation of NETFUND (Kenya) as the NIE

Having considered the recommendation of the Accreditation Panel, the Adaptation Fund Board decided to accredit the National Environment Trust Fund (NETFUND) of Kenya as a National Implementing Entity (NIE) of the Adaptation Fund for five years, as per paragraph 39 of the operational policies and guidelines for Parties to access resources from the Adaptation Fund. The accreditation expiration date would be 10 April 2030.

Re-accreditation of PACT (Belize)

Having considered the recommendation of the Accreditation Panel, the Adaptation Fund Board decided to re-accredit the Protected Areas Conservation Trust (PACT) of Belize as a National Implementing Entity (NIE) of the Adaptation Fund for five years, as per paragraph 39 of the operational policies and guidelines for Parties to access resources from the Adaptation Fund. The accreditation expiration date would be 10 April 2030.




Re-accreditation of FIRCA (Côte d'Ivoire)

Having considered the recommendation of the Accreditation Panel and following the re-accreditation process approved by Decisions B.28/38 and B.34/3, the Adaptation Fund Board decided to re-accredit the Interprofessional Fund for Agricultural Research and Advice (FIRCA) of Côte d'Ivoire as a National Implementing Entity (NIE) of the Adaptation Fund for five years, as per paragraph 39 of the operational policies and guidelines for Parties to access resources from the Adaptation Fund. The accreditation expiration date would be 10 April 2030.
