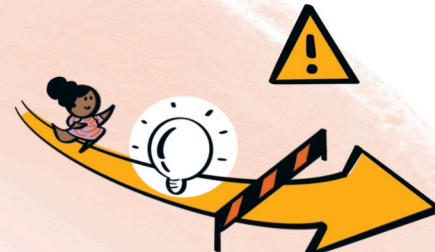

ENSURE A SUSTAINABILITY PLAN, ESTABLISH ROLES, SECURE RESOURCES AND MANAGE INFORMATION



ESTABLISH PARTNERSHIPS BETWEEN COMMUNITIES & INSTITUTIONS (e.g. DREDDs & NGOs) TO MAINTAIN INFRASTRUCTURE



LOCAL WOMEN'S ORGANIZATIONS HOLD GREAT POTENTIAL TO LEAD INCOME-GENERATING ACTIVITIES



WHEN COMMUNITIES SEE SHORT-TERM BENEFITS, RESULTS ARE MORE LIKELY TO BE SUSTAINED
